TOPIC: ARE MEN AND WOMEN TRULY EQUAL TODAY, OR ARE THE SUFFRAGISTS OF 1920 STILL SUFFERING IN 2020?

What can women, men, the media, and organizations such as AAUW do to ensure and sustain equality for women and men?

Background Information and Resources:

Women have been marching toward equality for over a century, starting with the Women's March of 1913 and continuing to the Women's Marches at present.

"We hold these truths to be self-evident: that all men and women are created equal; that they are endowed by their Creator with certain inalienable rights; that among these are life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness..." — The Declaration of Sentiments and Resolutions, Seneca Falls Conference, 1848. These words, written 171 years ago, proclaimed equality between men and women.

Abigail Adams urged her husband to "remember the ladies" when drafting our country's founding documents: "I desire you would remember the ladies and be more generous and favorable to them than your ancestors. Do not put such unlimited power into the hands of the husbands. Remember, all men would be tyrants if they could. If particular care and attention is not paid to the ladies, we are determined to foment a rebellion, and will not hold ourselves bound by any laws in which we have no voice or representation." Has society "remembered the ladies"?

CONTEST INSTRUCTIONS

Eligibility: The AAUW Roseville-South Placer's **Speech Trek Contest** is open to all actively attending high school students in South and West Placer County, whether from public, private, home-school or continuation high schools. Students who were previously selected as one of the top three finalists for the CA STATE FINAL may not compete again.

Time Limits: Students are to prepare an original 5:00-6:00 minute speech, with a 30-second grace period on either side. **Speaking under 4:30 or over 6:30 will result in disqualification.**

Presentation: These presentations are to be original speeches. Appropriate use of **one** 4" x 6" note card is an option. Prompting is not allowed.

Judging: During the Local Semi-Final and Local Final competitions, judges will use the AAUW Roseville-South Placer Branch's scoring ballot. (sample p. 4). If a student advances to the State Final, she/he will receive a sample copy of the State's judge's ballot. Judge's will score each speaker in two areas: Content (includes Introduction, Organization and Conclusion), 0-50 points; and Delivery, 0-50 points.

Local Final: Friday, February 21, 2020, 4:00 PM, Kilaga Springs Lodge, Lincoln, CA
State Final: Saturday, April 18, 2020, Westin San Francisco Airport Hotel, Millbrae, CA.
Local Final Winner may qualify for CA State Final. AAUW Roseville-South Placer Branch will post the video of the first place winner's speech online by March 1, 2020. The State Speech Trek judges will identify five finalists, two of whom will be named as Honorable Mention. The State Speech Trek judges will invite the top three finalists to compete for cash prizes at the AAUW CA State Finals at Convention/Annual Meeting on Saturday, April 18, 2020, at the Westin San Francisco Airport Hotel. Travel, lodging, and meals for each finalist and her/his chaperone will be reimbursed by Speech Trek. Those expenses should not exceed approved budget.
